When does registration for the 2021 Annual Conference close?

If you have a speaking role, please register by June 18 to confirm participation. Note, however, that registration does not close. You are able to register at any point through this link:

Will the papers presented be published?

No, the conference will not be publishing papers or proceedings.

Can I receive a certificate for my participation in the 2021 Annual Conference?

Yes. ACUNS can provide roundtable participants and paper authors with certificates.

How long are each of the panels during the Conference?

Each session is scheduled for 75 minutes. Working paper panels include 3-4 paper presentations; roundtable have 4-6 presenting participants. Presenters will have approximately 10 minutes to present (depending on how many others there are). After presentations, please leave ample time (approximately 30 minutes) for Q&A.

I paid the registration fee for the Conference but I can no longer attend. Will I be refunded?

Unfortunately, no, ACUNS will not be able to provide refunds.

How much is the registration fee?

For non-ACUNS members, the fee is \$30 to join the Conference either as an attendee or a participant. Registration is free for ACUNS members. You can become a member through this link: <https://acuns.org/acuns-membership/individual-benefits/> (Note that ACUNS membership dues are scaled by income level. Individual member dues range from \$5 to \$280 per year, depending on self-reported income).

Do I have to become a member to participate in the Conference?

What is included in the registration fee?

All attendees must register in order to have access to the Annual Meeting Portal, which provides the Zoom links for each of the Sessions.

Is registration mandatory?

Yes. You must register to have access to all the Zoom links through the Annual Meeting Portal.
